A cheque for £200,000 was handed over by our PGM to the President of the Masonic Charitable Foundation VW Bro Richard Hone QC to help kick start the Festival. It was a great start to the Festival and something we should all be very proud of.

The Festival is officially 3 months old and it is very encouraging to know that, in any Lodge members of the Executive or Provincial Officers go to, the Festival is being spoken about. Charity Stewards are encouraging members to start <u>regular donations</u> using gift aid. Propositions are being made to donate monies from Lodge Relief Chests to the Festival Relief Chest and gift aid envelopes are being used to collect alms to assist in raising extra funds.

Brethren I cannot tell you how good it is to know that we as a Province are so fully supportive of the Festival. The Festival does not finish until October 2021 so we have a long was to go. However, we will succeed as long as we make it fun and enjoyable and understand why we are raising the money for such a fantastic Charity.

I pleased to announce that over 80% of all Bucks Lodges have either donated or have brethren pledging regular donations. This does mean that there are 20% who have not yet started, but some Lodges may be using their own Relief Chests and will then transfer to the Festival when the time is right for them. In short I know every Lodge is doing something which is great.
